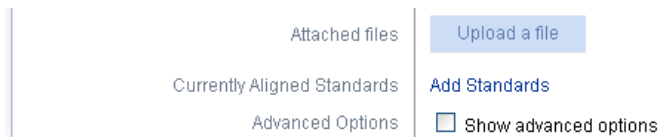


## Adding Standards to an Answer Sheet Assessment

One of the most powerful reporting features in DataDirector is the ability to see how students performed on standards. This allows teachers to zero in on the specific content that was mastered or needs to be re-addressed.

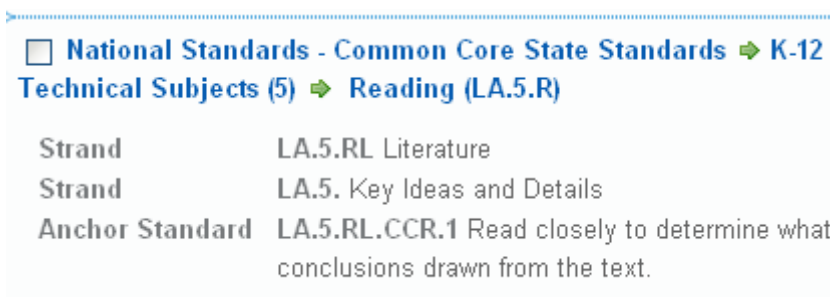
1. In the “Edit Assessment” screen, select Add Standards.



2. After clicking on Add Standards, expand and select the standards you wish to add, and then click Search.



3. DataDirector will return your results. Add the standards by clicking the box. Standards are automatically added to the assessment.



4. When you return to your assessment, you will see the added standards.

Add Standards

- National Standards MA.3.3.OA.1** (3) Interpret products of whole numbers.
- National Standards MA.3.3.OA.3** (3) Use multiplication and division within 100 to solve word problems in situations involving equal groups, arrays, and measurement quantities, e.g., by using drawings and equations with a symbol for the unknown number to represent the problem.
- National Standards MA.3.3.OA.4** (3) Determine the unknown whole number in a multiplication or division equation relating three whole numbers.

5. To add the standards to individual questions, select “None” in the Standards column.

6. A window will pop up containing the standards the user added to the assessment. Check which standards you would like to attach to the question and click “Done”.
