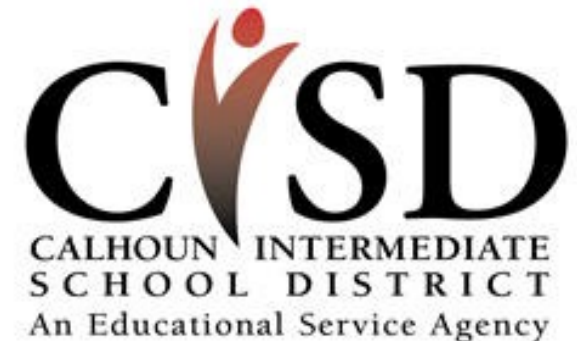

DataDirector for Administrators— Beginner (DATA 560)

April 9th 8:30-11:45 CISD—FREE

This session will uncover the basics of DataDirector as it pertains to today's school administrator. Participants will learn why DataDirector can be a tool to efficiently collect and analyze student data. In addition, administrators will explore the navigation and structure of DataDirector as well as how to use MEAP, MME, DIBELS, and MI-ACCESS pre-built reports.

DataDirector for Administrators— Intermediate (DATA 660)

April 19th 8:30-11:45 CACC—FREE

This course is designed as a follow up to the beginner course for administrators. Topics included in this course include creating assessments and exams, collecting data with bubble sheets and scanners. Finally, administrators will learn what reports to use to maximize their participation in PLCs and teacher evaluations.

Leave this session with an understanding of the available data within DataDirector as well as the ability to create reports that will help with evaluations and Child Study Team meetings. Finally, learn to create a communication plan that will ensure you have access to classroom data that will help streamline your collection process.

DataDirector for Special Education Teachers (DATA 669)

May 2nd 8:30-3:30 CISD—FREE

Participants in this session will learn how to access students on their caseload as well as classroom assessment data that can be used to set and track IEP goals. Are you keeping track with a clipboard and pencil? Learn how to create your own assessments in DataDirector in order to quickly organize and access student academic and demographic data. Leave feeling confident that special education teachers DO have a place in DataDirector!
