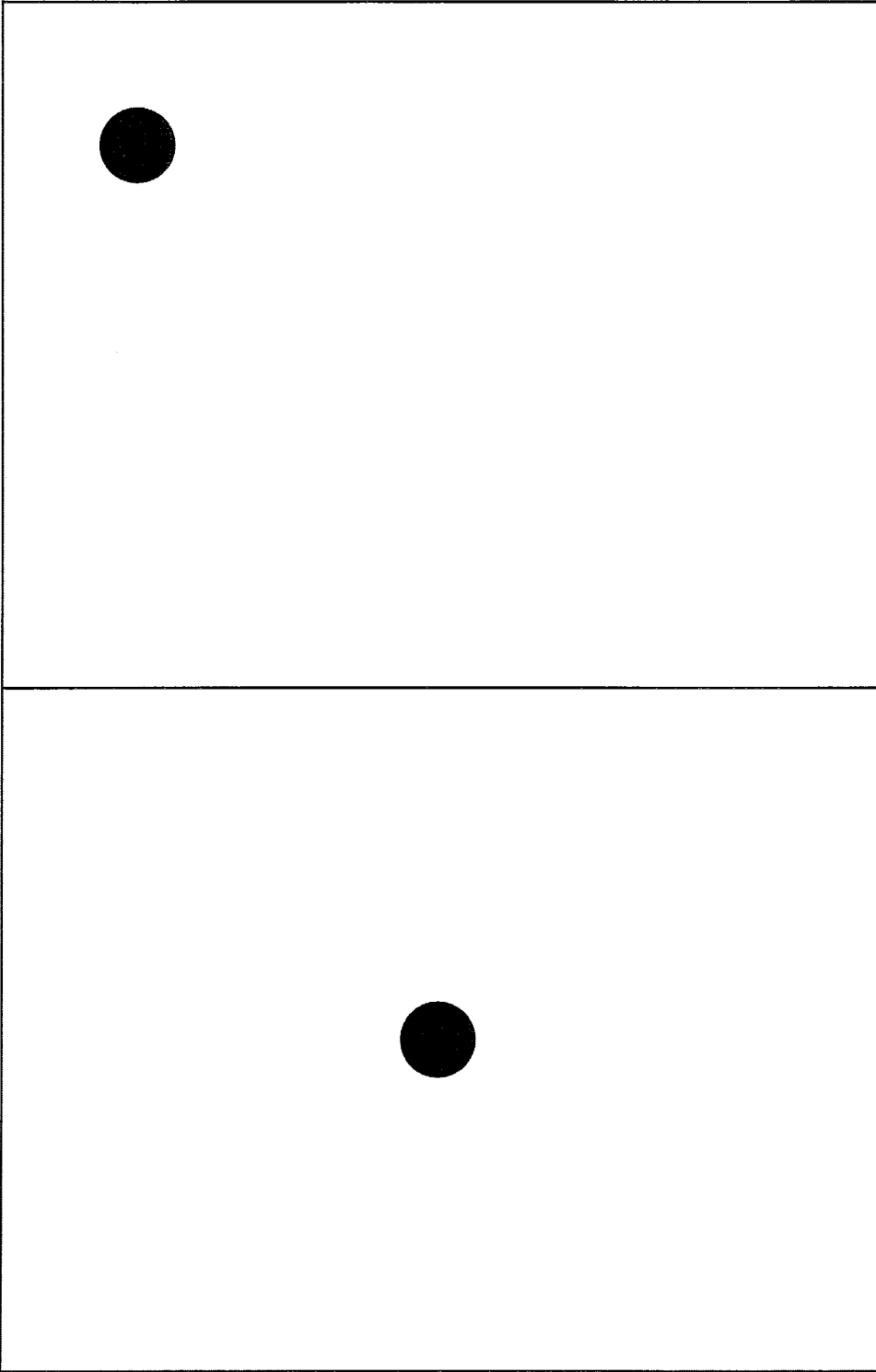


Dot cards can be used to enhance number sense.

Help students with their ability to subitize (recognition of domino and dice patterns).

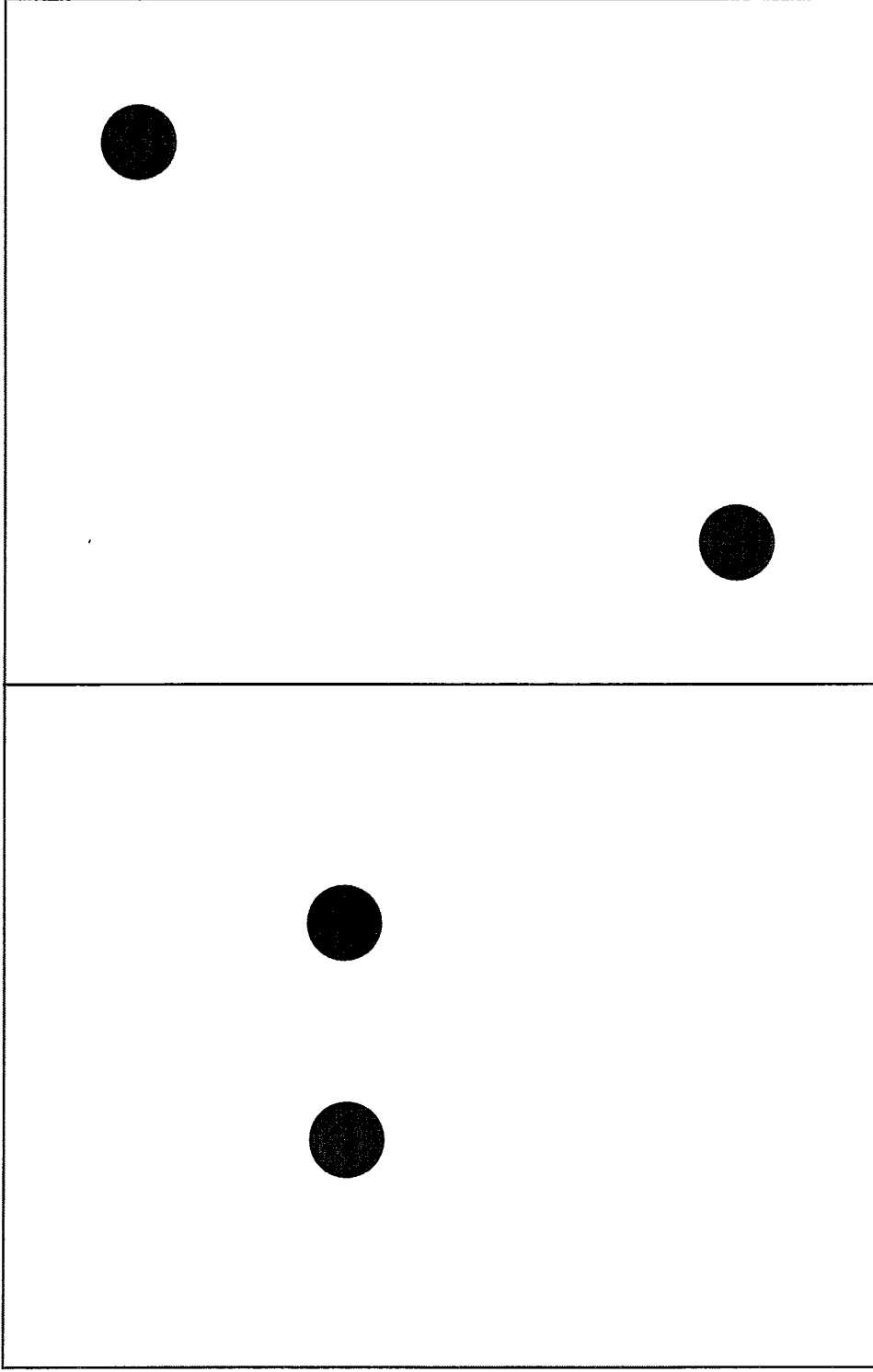

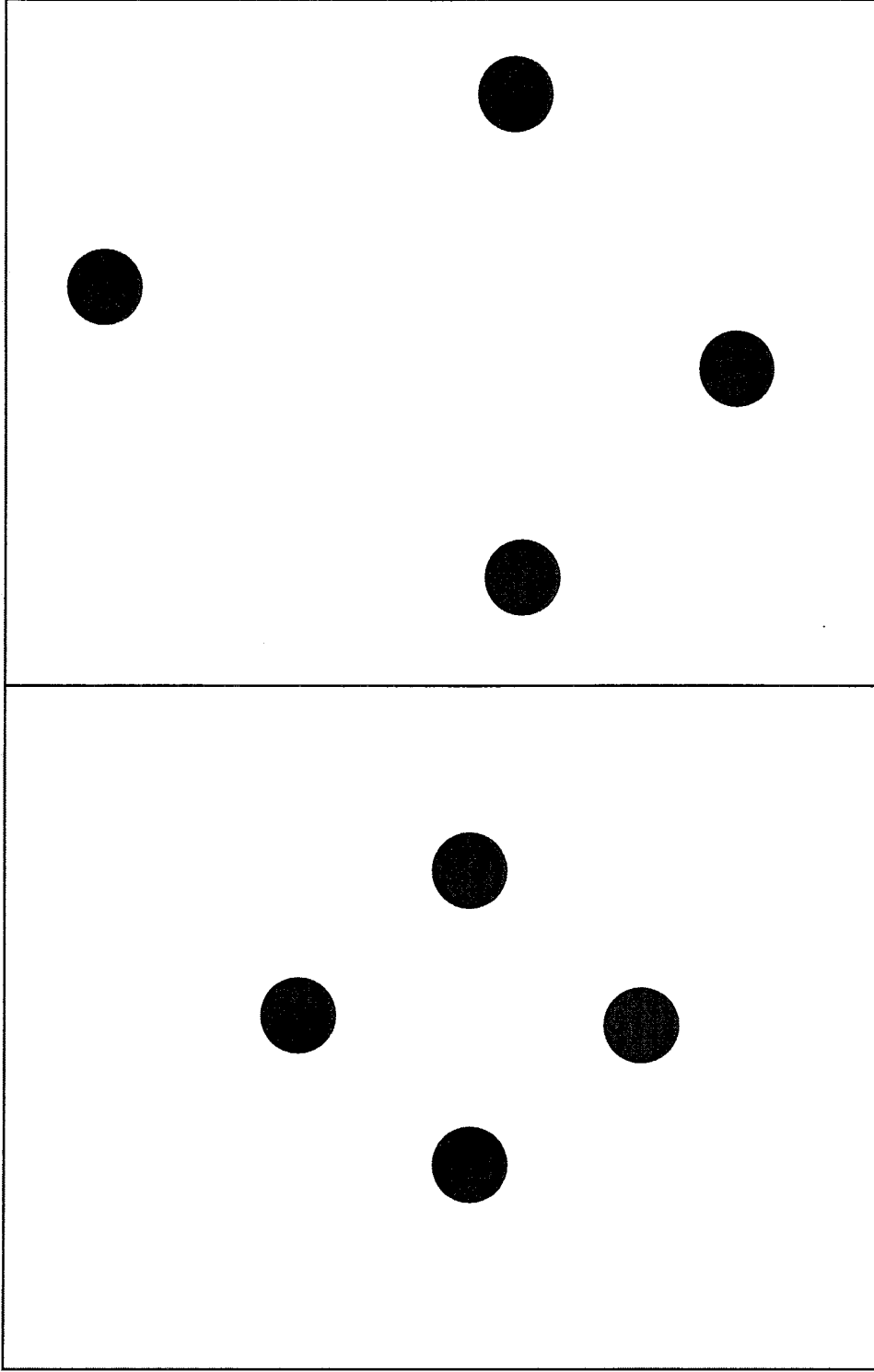

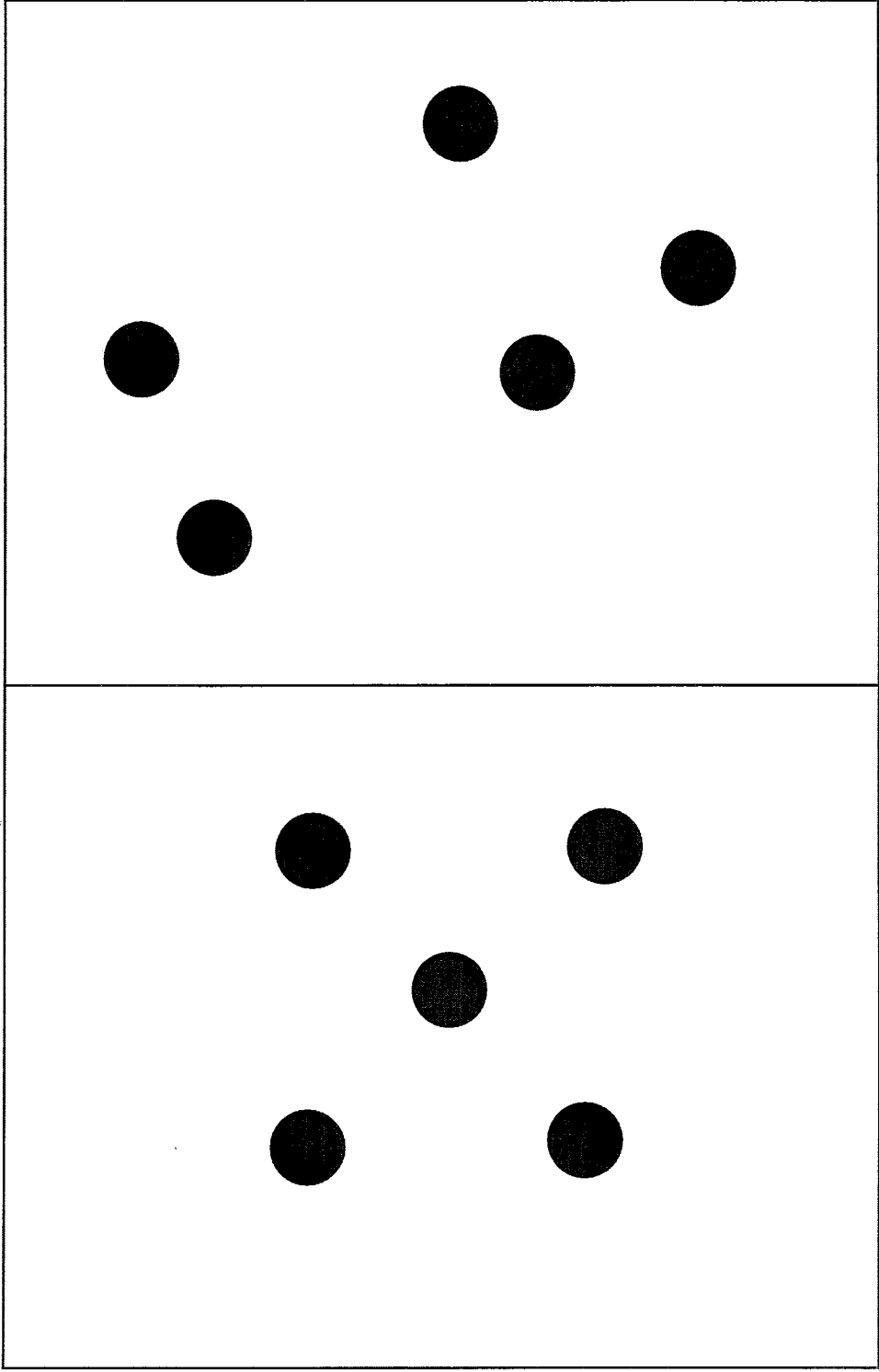

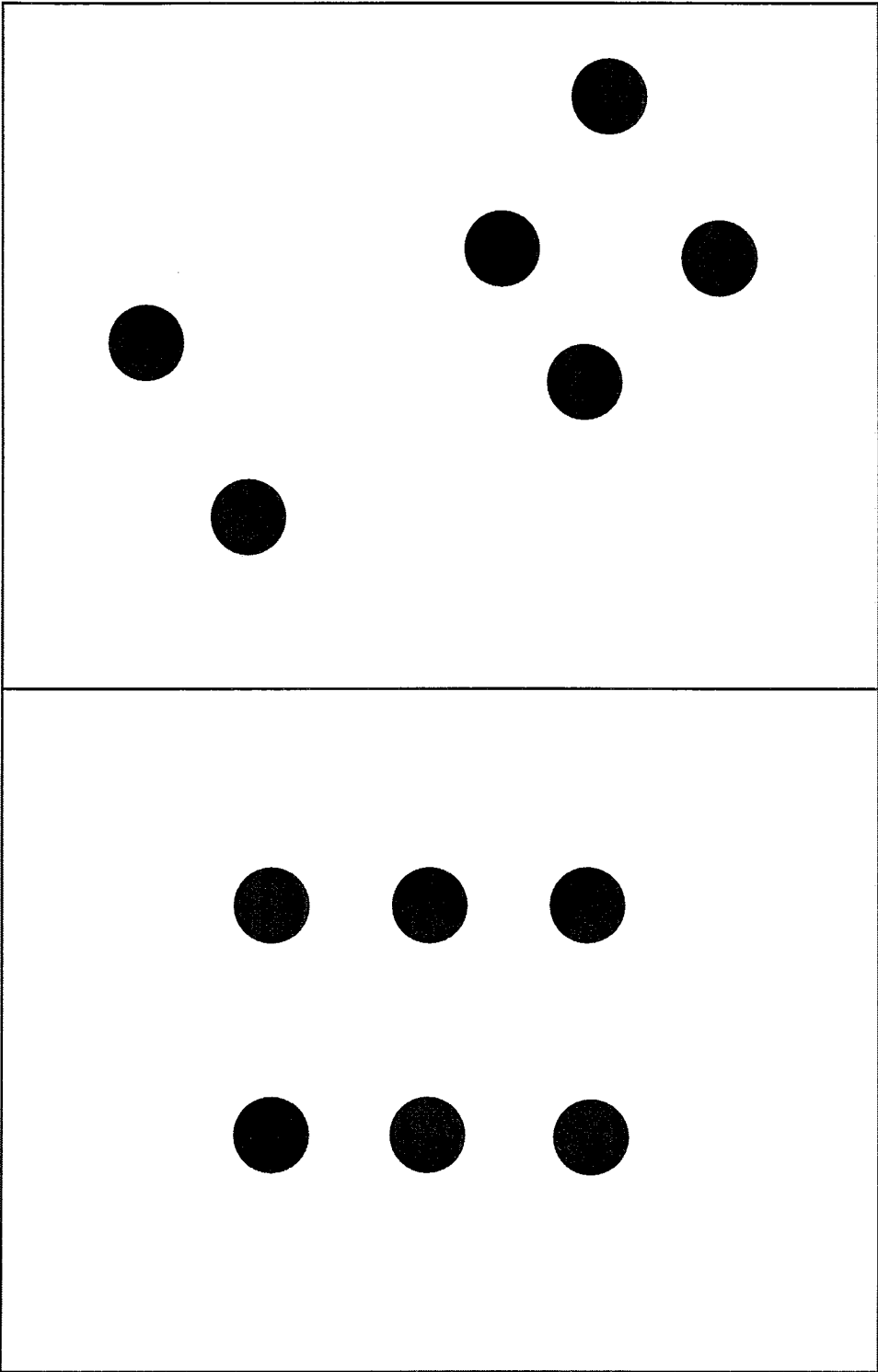

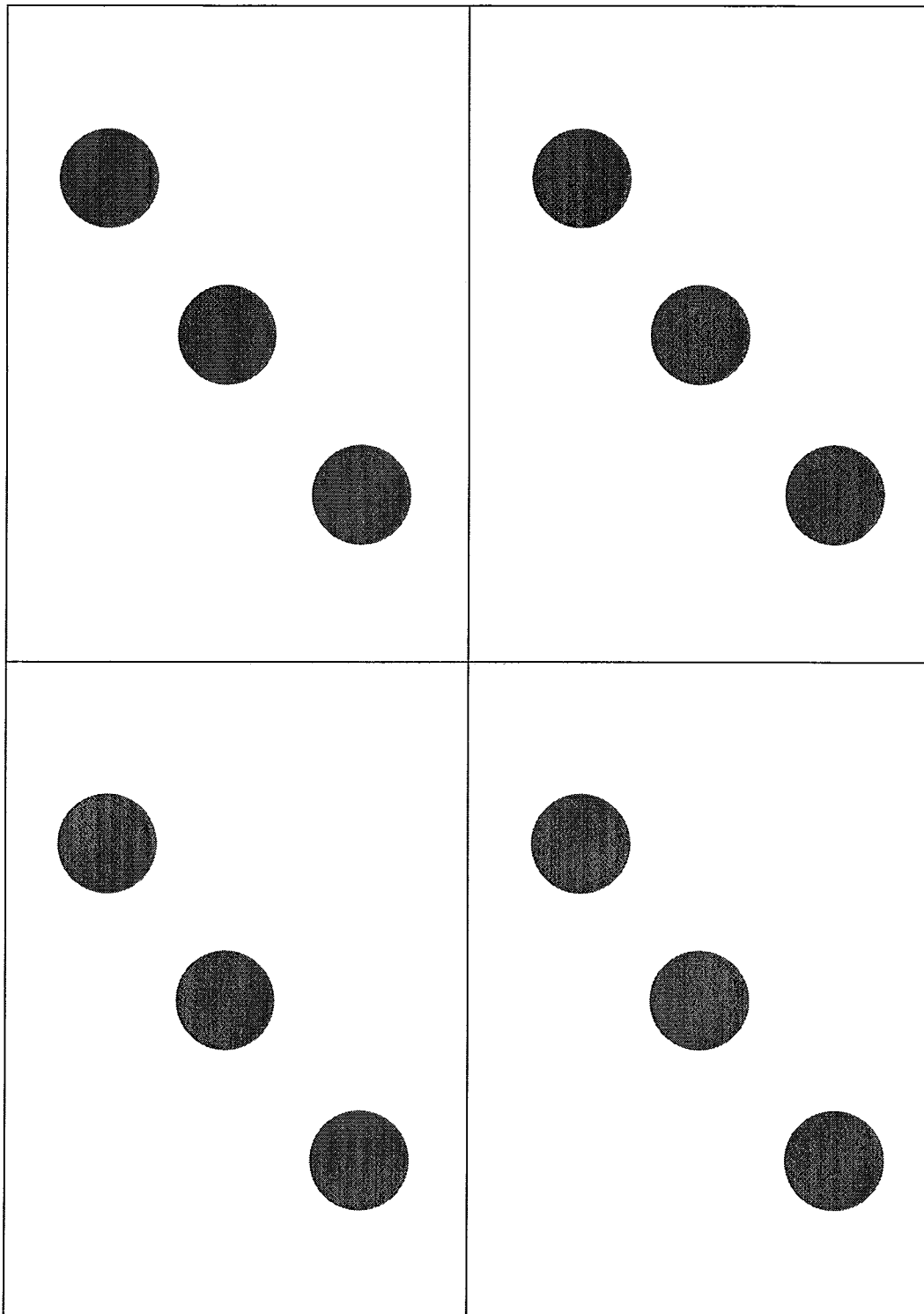

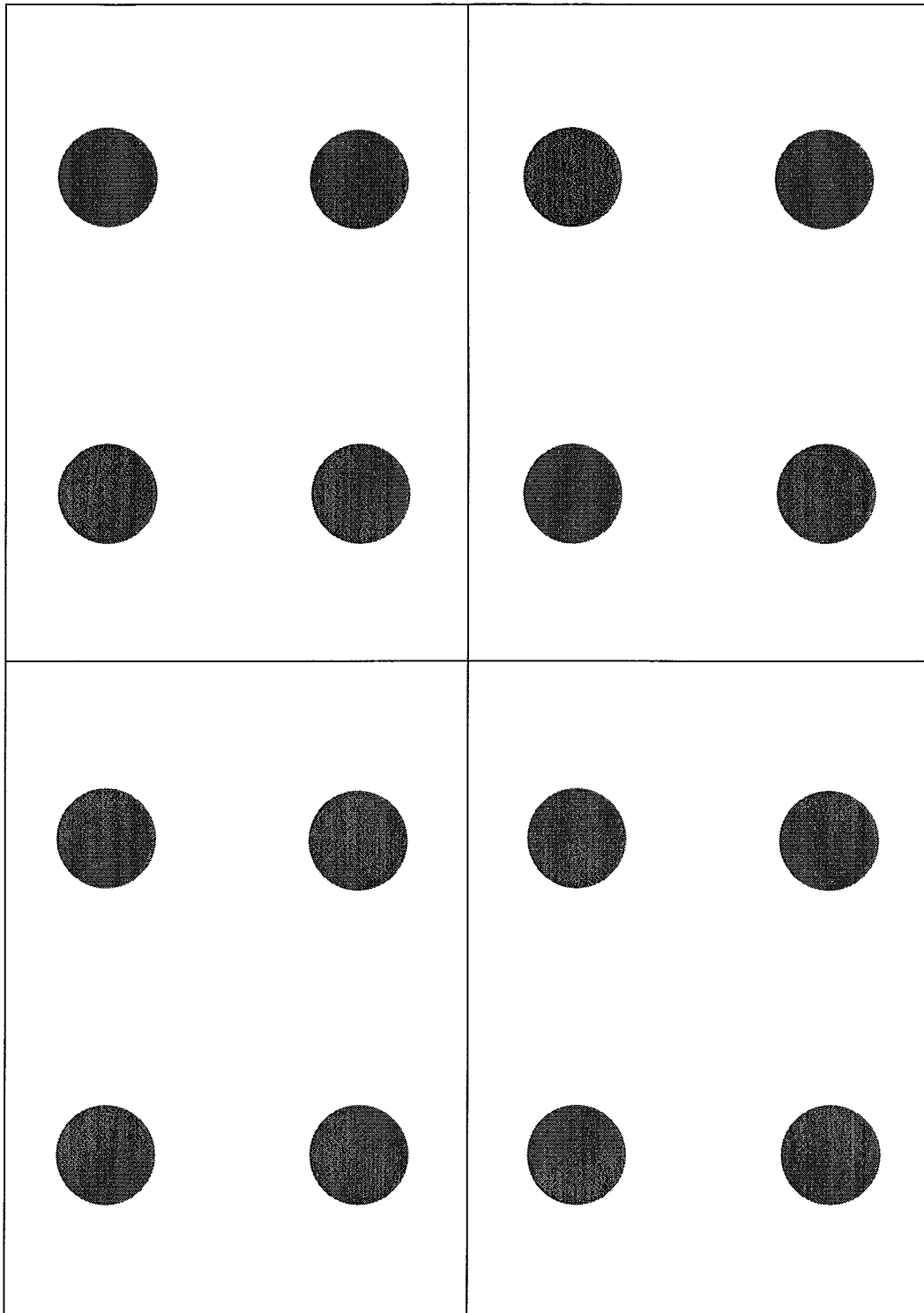

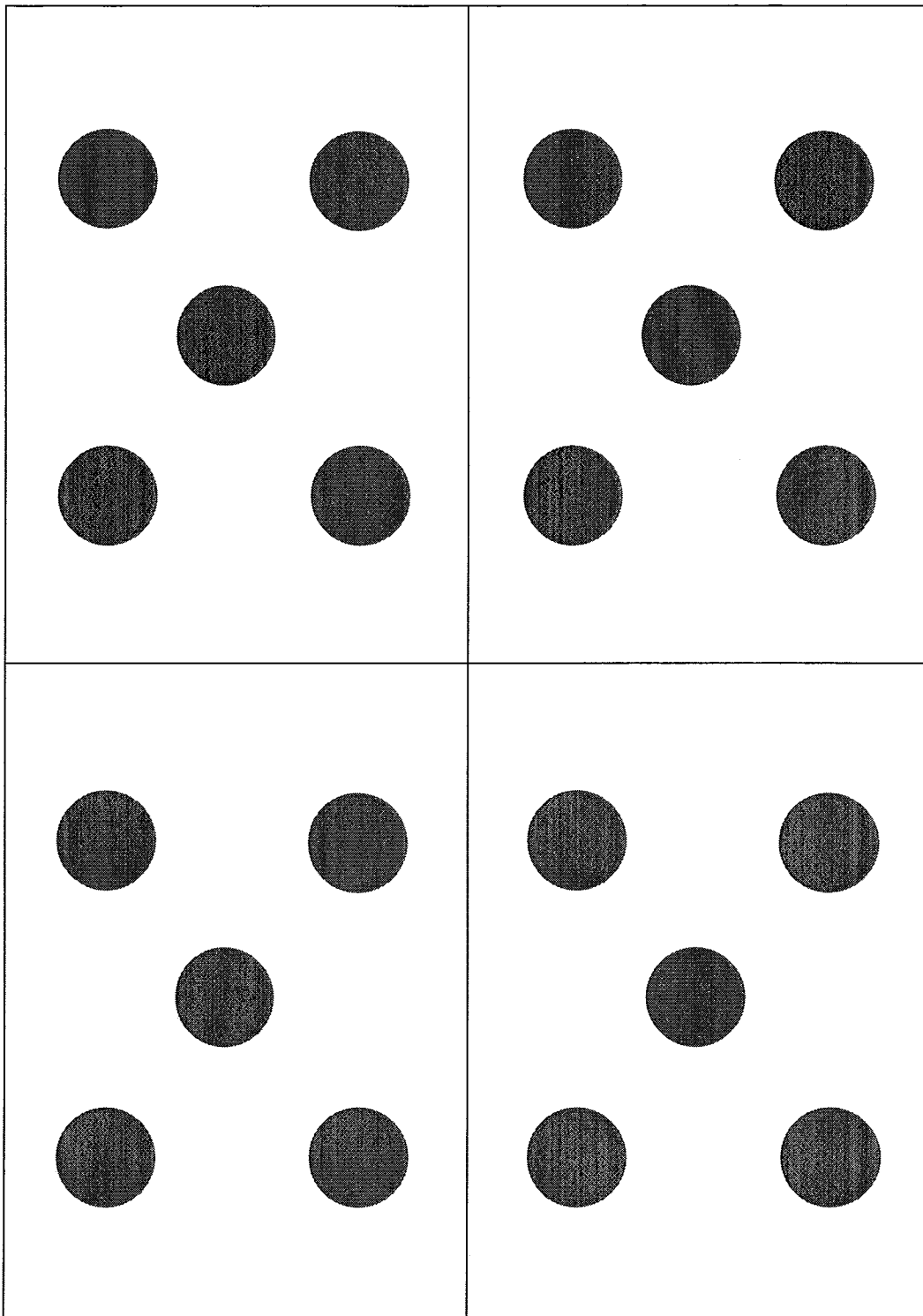
Three Dot Cards
